

Most of the revisions simply moved officer job descriptions and specifics into the standing rules. Some of the major revisions being considered include: (a) changing the name of our Association to the State of Texas, (b) replacing TSELF with a Foundation Ambassador role and (c) changing the composition of the voting body at State Convention.
